## **Bunk Bed Assembly**

Tools needed: Power drill or impact driver with T25 (torx) star bit, carpenters square, clamps(helpful)

Bunk bed parts list: 4 ladder or headboard/footboard pieces.

4 side rails, packaged in sets of 2.

2 safety rails, packaged in set.

2 sets of slats, packaged in set of 7.

Bag of screws and dowel rods

Finish on bunk bed is Minwax premium oil, semi-transparent – Jacobean 2750 - This can be used for touch ups or a dark permanent marker.

1. Ladder pieces(headboard/footboard) should have ladder rungs facing out away from mattress. Using supplied screws, mount side rails just above lowest ladder rung. 6 screws into each post, start with one screw in and make sure rail and ladder are square before screwing the other screws. Using a small clamp to hold in place is useful. Also, make sure the support cleat on rail is tight against the ladder post.




- 2. Mount the other side rail on other side in the same manner. Make sure that the rail and ladder are square, and that support cleat is tight against ladder post.
- 3. Insert dowels into predrilled holes in top of ladder pieces.
- 4. Place ladder pieces on top, with ladder rungs facing out, inserting dowels into bottom of predrilled ladder pieces.
- 5. Assemble top bed the same way as lower bed.
- 6. The top bunk also gets safety rails mounted just above the top rung of ladder.



- 7. Place slats between rails and distribute evenly. 7 slats per bed.
- 8. Place mattresses and bedding on slats.





- <u>Assembly Tools to bring with you</u> 2 clamps (6" minimum) trigger style works well
  - Square rafters square or similar -
  - Cordless drill with T25 bit
  - Deck Screws 56 per bunk bed for assembly 24 for twin bed (plus extra!)
